Anahid Mardirosyan was born in Tehran, Iran. Her family repatriated to Armenia in 1965. She has graduated from Pedagogical University after Abovyan. Her major was philology. She has also completed the Studio of Art of Recital under the supervision of well-known recital specialist Susanna Gabrielyan. Her professional career began in 1979 at the secondary school #79. She taught Armenian Literature and Armenian Language there. She worked with the Public Radio of Armenia and at Moscow Lazaryan Seminary as a teacher of Armenian Language and Armenian Literature.

Her family moved to the United States of America in 1991. Here she started to work with Fidanyan Radio as a speaker and editor. She worked with Davtyan-Mariamian educational Center and HOM (Armenian Aid Organization). She has been the special correspondent of the Magazine Zvatnots. For about 18 years she has been working with AMGA (Armenian Media Group of Armenia) as a speaker and executive chief of Zhamanak News Program. She has meanwhile been hosting Hayatsk TV Program. She has been performing and introducing her recitals of Armenian poetry, and art all over the world. She has been actively participating in social issues. She has organized more than 30 concerts that were of great success.
