Sabrina Hunter Morales began dance lessons at the age of 5. She studied ballet, tap, jazz, folk/character, and mime under former professional dancers from international companies – including a master class with Jacques D’Amboise – while attending Butler University and Chautauqua Institute in New York. She also performed in the Institute’s production of *Hansel and Gretel*. A former dance instructor herself, she is an award-winning choreographer for a South Carolina production of *Nunsense*, in which she also performed the role of Sr. Mary Leo. She danced in several musical theatrical productions (including, among others, *A Chorus Line*, *Kiss Me Kate*, *Bubblin’ Brown Sugar*, and *Purlie*); and she has also choreographed for show choirs, dance troupes, praise dance teams, and marching band pom pom/flag corps.

After obtaining her Bachelor of Music Education from Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa, and her Masters in Music (clarinet and piano) from Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana, she taught band and choir in grades 4-12. She has been a Musical Director, vocal coach, pianist and performer in professional summer stock and community theatrical productions; and an organist and Director of Music for several churches.

She is also an actress, signed with the Kolstein Talent Agency, and has had roles in commercials, industrials, television and film, and has appeared in print.
