## BUILDING LIVES ON CHRIST MINISTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Be present at all Two or More and/or Confirmation Wednesday night activities from 5:20 to 8:00. If you are unable to attend you must notify the Education Youth Coordinator prior to that event. All BLOC Team members are required to check in and check out each evening with the Education & Youth Coordinator.
2. Attend a week of leadership training at The Shores of St. Andrews Bible Camp. (BLOC Team members are to pay \$125 to attend camp, the remainder of the camp fee will be paid for by St. James) We have scheduled the week of June 19-24. There will also be a few days in late August when you need to be available during the week for additional training at St. James.
3. Attend 2 – 3 other activities, events, etc. which the Two or More may be involved in throughout the year. Be aware that this could include time over spring break, MEA, etc.
4. Commit to reading the bible regularly and/or one of the Bibles the children read and/or regularly reading another devotional book.
5. Worship regularly and be visible and supportive of youth and children's ministry.
6. Participate in worship on a regular basis (i.e. children's message giver, serve communion, usher, reader or technical support).
7. Hold peers accountable to the above requirements through phone calls, prayer and other support
8. Attend 2 – 3 other 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade youth activities, events, etc. throughout the year.
